The event : Take a line for a walk

The exhibition explores a theme common to both artists and architects: the line.

The line is used by artists and architects to create two and three-dimensional shapes in architecture and to shape forms on a canvas or a sheet of paper. The line is also formed by the path created by visitors as they wander through the space. And, because a line can also be produced by writers, who form it with their words, this event will include conversations with writers.

François Morellet's 2001 work *Pi piquant 1=45°, 50 décimales* is the starting point for this stroll: take a line for a walk.

The line can be solid and visible, or interstitial and to be figured out.

The exhibition features works by : Simon Boudvin, François Morellet, Mathieu Schmitt, Xavier Theunis, Peaks architects, Krijn de Koning, Caroline Sebilleau and Esther Tielemans.
